Scarf tying instructions for hats with an attached head scarf



STYLE 1 - LEVEL: EASY

After you put the hat on, either drape the chemo scarf over the head to cover the hat or fold the scarf to create a "band" around the hat. Tie the ends in a simple knot at the back.



STYLE 3 - LEVEL: MODERATE

Follow the instructions in style 1. Take both ends and twist them around each other. Keep twisting until it starts to curl up into itself. Next, keeping a finger in the centre at the back of the hat, wind the cord round your finger as if creating a "bun" or rosette. With the remaining ends of the chemo scarf, push them part the way through the centre of the rosette to secure it in place.



STYLE 2 - LEVEL: EASY

Follow the instructions in style 1, then tuck the ends back over themselves – feeding them between the knot and the hat. Secure the style by pulling the two loops tight, creating the illusion of a bow.



STYLE 4 - MODERATE

Follow the instructions in style 1. Take one end in turn and twist it so that it forms a tight rope-like cord, then bring it around to the front of the head and tuck the end securely into the band at the front of the hat. Repeat the process with the remaining end. You can secure this with a pin if you feel you need a bit of extra grip.
